Gesh Salvador is the Filmmaker representing Nigeria in a grant of €80,000 by the European Union for the development of a Pan-African movie between Nigeria, Ghana and Togo, scheduled to be released in 2025.




THE WOMAN WHO KILLED GOD




DEATH IS A NAUGHTY KIND OF HUMAN


THE GIRL WHO BRINGS DEATH

When a group of delinquent youths recklessly run a girl to death with their car during a night out of drugs and booze, they drive themselves into a dangerous rabbit hole of blackmail.


To get out alive, they must do everything to bail themselves out of the crime within 48 hours, even if it means losing their souls towards committing a hundred more crimes, or else..

A seductive fusion of *Jordan Peele-esque* horror, *Tarantino's* pop-culture-laced violence, and the stylish surrealism of *Euphoria*, but set in the vivid, chaotic heat of Nigerian youth culture.
